During your time here, information is shared about the farm, the district and the progressive story of Simply Tomatoes, Aussie Wool Quilts and Woolly Warmers: giving you a window into the life of a farming family, hearing about the journey of national award winning products recognised by the Premier of Victoria for innovation.

It really is amazing to see the diversity here: specialty green tomato products, wool bedding, Woolly Warmers body shaped therapeutic heat pads and of course tourism. 11.45am - SALUTE OLIVA translates as "Cheers to good health with Olives". Salute Oliva is situated on the eastern edge of Boort. This family owned grove produces first class extra virgin olive oil and a range of table olives. Grown organically, the olives are processed using only natural ingredients with traditional pickling methods. The oil and the olives are available for sale in various package sizes. Also sold on site are jams, preserves, olive oil soaps and gift packs. Swiss couple, Peter & Marlies Eicher, are the friendly & engaging hosts of this absorbing attraction.

2.30pm - SPANNER SCULPTURE GARDEN Piccolis' farm has 2 acres of beautiful garden, a wonderful array of birds, including rare macaws and of course the world class sculptures that have been designed, created and erected by John Piccoli, made entirely from spanners. It is hard to do justice to this fascinating attraction, people come from far and wide to see it. Everybody loves it!
